Midstream urine collection

- 1. Do not empty your bladder for 3 hours, if possible.
- Ensure the container is labelled with your surname, first name, date of birth, gender, time and date of collection.
- Wash your hands, and then wash your genital area with the sterile water wipe that has been provided.
- Females should hold the labia apart while the specimen is passed. If you have vaginal discharge or monthly periods, a tampon should be inserted.
- 5. Uncircumcised males should retract the foreskin whilst the specimen is being passed.

- 6. Pass the first part of the urine stream into the toilet, then without stopping the flow, place the specimen container under the urine stream until it is 1/3 full. Finish passing the rest of the urine into the toilet.
- 7. Do not touch the inside of the container as it is sterile.
- **8.** Replace the lid of the container, making sure it is firmly screwed on.
- Specimen should preferably be refrigerated after collection and returned to the collection centre or doctor's surgery as soon as possible.
