

SEMEN ANALYSIS - FERTILITY ASSESSMENT

Your doctor has requested examination of a semen specimen in order to assess fertility. This examination requires a specimen which has been collected properly and transported rapidly and under appropriate conditions. Please follow the instructions below as closely as possible.

Collection of specimen

Collection centres and laboratories are not equipped for semen collections. This should take place at home.

- Abstain from ejaculation for 2-7 days.
- Collect complete ejaculate (by masturbation) into the container provided.
- Ensure the container is labelled with your surname, first name, date of birth, time and date of collection.
- 4. Mark the container 'Fertility'.
- 5. Do not refrigerate.

Delivery of specimens

- Deliver to the nearest laboratory (see overleaf) as rapidly as possible, ideally within 1 hour of collection. Delayed examination may lead to an invalid result and the need to recollect
- If you cannot deliver the specimen directly to the nearest laboratory, it can be taken to a collection centre, but this may cause transport delay and affect the results.
